

Belgian Beatbox Championships 2018

Belgian Rules:

- The contestant needs to be registered via the sign-up form found at www.beatbox.be
- The contestant must have the Belgian nationality.
- The contestant must show his/her ID-card at the entrance.
- The contestant must follow the time schedule below.
- The contestant agrees to be recorded in audio and video, by the organisers of the event and allows them to use this recorded content in any way.
- Violating one of these rules can lead to immediate disqualification.

Time schedule for contestants:

- 12h45 Your time of arrival at De Centrale, Ghent. Please notify us if you are delayed.
- 13h00 Doors open for audience.
- 13h15 Start "Solo - elimination round" (all solo contestants must be present at the stage).
- 15h15 Start "Solo - quarterfinals" (all solo contestants must be present at the stage).
- 15h55 Start "Loop Station - finals" (all LS contestants must be present at the stage).
- 16h25 Start "Solo - semi-finals" (all solo semi-finalists must be present at the stage).
- 16h45 Start "Tag Team - finals" (all tag team finalists must be present at the stage).
- 17h00 Start "Solo - finals" (all solo finalists must be present at the stage).
- 17h15 Showcases Judges.
- 17h40 Award ceremony (all contestants must be present at the stage).

Order and rules of Beatbox Battle®

System of the contest:

In the elimination round each participant presents a 2 minute long beatbox session. The judges will rank all the participants. The top eight will move on to the quarter final.

In the quarter-final the participants get paired up to battle 1vs1. Rank 1 will battle rank 8. Rank 2 will battle rank 7. Rank 3 will battle rank 6. Rank 4 will battle rank 5.

Each beatboxer gets 2 times 90 seconds and they take turns. Ex. Beatboxer A: 90 seconds, Beatboxer B: 90 seconds, Beatboxer A: 90 seconds, Beatboxer B: 90 seconds. After immediate jury deliberation, the winner will be announced and he/she will move on to the semi final.

This structure will be applied to all battles and rounds from quarter finals to the grand final

Solo battles

Order of contest:

Elimination round - Participants unlimited	1 x 120 seconds
Quarter final - 8 participants	2 x 90 seconds
Semi-final - 4 participants	2 x 90 seconds
Final - 2 participants	2 x 90 seconds

Tag team battles

Order of contest:

Qualifying round - Participants unlimited	1 x 120 seconds (online video by 24/03 latest 12h00)
Final - 2 participants	2 x 90 seconds

Loop station battles

Order of contest:

Qualifying round - Participants unlimited	1 x 180 seconds (online video by 24/03 latest 12h00)
Final - 2 participants	2 x 180 seconds

Rules of the contest:

1. All sounds that are made out of the human organs are allowed.
2. No other aid than a Shure Beta 58 microphone is allowed.
3. Dangerous body contacts during the battles will lead to immediate disqualification.
4. There are two microphones available at the contests which will be set on a uniformly level by the jury to make sure that all participants compete on the same conditions.
